10 things to optimize before you start pinning

- Use a clear business name in your profile name
Your name should include your brand and niche.

- Choose a clean profile photo or logo
Avoid blurry or cropped images.

- Write a benefit-focused bio
Tell people what result you help them get.

- Add your website URL to your profile
Make sure the link works.

- Claim your website inside Pinterest settings
This improves analytics and trust.

- Enable rich pins
They help Pinterest understand your content.

- Create at least 10 keyword-rich boards
Avoid vague or cutesy names.

- Write keyword-rich board descriptions
Pinterest reads these for SEO.

- Seed each board with 5–10 relevant pins
Give Pinterest more context.

- Make sure your content matches your niche
Consistency boosts visibility.

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
